Our Programs



For over two decades, Young Debs Inc. has empowered young men and women in the Baltimore metropolitan area with mentorship, guidance, and opportunities for growth. Supported by dedicated mentors and volunteers, our programs shape respectful, ethical, and hardworking individuals prepared to succeed in life. Our programs are longitudinal and we will follow our students from 3rd thru 12th grade. Discover how our programs can inspire and empower your student to reach their full potential. Explore our programs below:

YOUNG & JUNIOR DEBS AND GENTS/BEAUS (GRADES 3-11):

Running from October to June, this foundational program offers mentorship, etiquette training, life skills sessions, and cultural activities, emphasizing character building, confidence, and well-rounded development. Students may also participate in our Performing Arts Outreach Program.

SENIOR DEBUTANTES AND BEAUS MENTOR & SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (GRADE 12):

This program includes all the benefits of the Young and Junior Debutante/Geta programs and adds a focus on preparing students for adulthood. Students receive mentorship, career and college readiness, assistance with applications, mock interviews, and scholarships. The culminating event is the Lavender Ball in June.



PERFORMING ARTS OUTREACH PROGRAM (GRADES 3-12):

Held during the school year (and sometimes during the summer months), this program introduces students to musical theatre, including acting, dance, vocals, and stage design, culminating in youth productions and performance opportunities. Students usually practice twice weekly.

Participation Guidelines & Associated Costs

Requirements:

- Maintain a B (80%) average
- Exhibit respect for self and others
- Attend etiquette classes, youth workshops and monthly events
- Participate in community service

Expectations:

- Report to school prepared and on time
- Present oneself appropriately at all times
- Demonstrate honor, integrity, and good citizenship
- Take responsibility for actions and behavior

Dues:

- \$550 (covers the total cost of the Debs & Beaus programs including trips)
- A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required to enroll (deducted from total dues)
- **Payment plans available; some student sponsorships are offered.**
